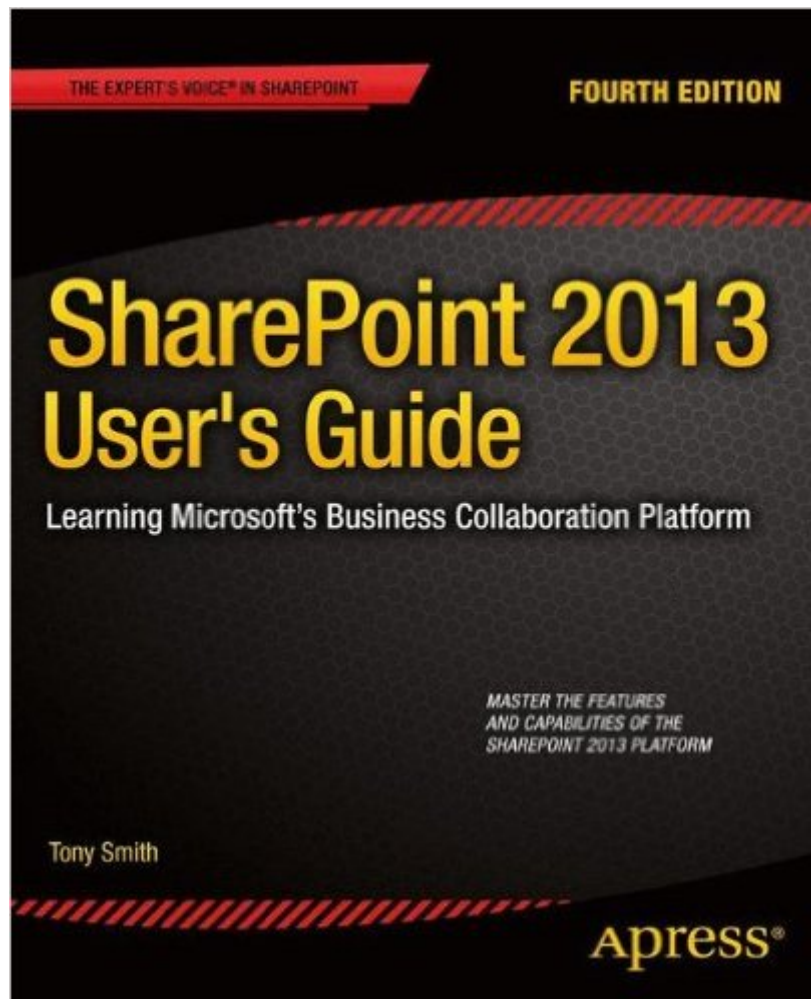


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SharePoint 2013 User's Guide: Learning Microsoft's Business Collaboration Platform

I have been working with SharePoint since version 2003, and I have been using this book since its SharePoint 2010 edition. The book started out with basic SharePoint fundamentals and then dove into details of each feature, what they were for and how to use them. The language was easy to understand and the instructions were very clear.
